## Driver's Medical

---

The Superintendent of Motor Vehicles is responsible for assessing drivers and making driver fitness decisions. One of the tools used for assessment is the Drivers Medical Examination Report. Driver Medical Examination Reports are completed at various times and intervals depending on:

- The age of the driver;
- The class of driver's license held;
- When a driver has a medical condition that may affect driving or when a reliable report of a potentially dangerous condition that may affect driving is received.

Patient will receive this in the mail, once received please call your family physician in our office to book an appointment. At the time of booking we will ask you whether it is a blue outlined form or yellow outlined.

Fees are as listed below:

Yellow Form - Over 75 is \$75.00

Yellow Form - Under 75 is \$150.00

Blue Form - Over 75 MSP covered

Blue Form - 75 under is \$75.00

An eye exam will be done during your visit.

Please bring the following to your appointment:

- BC Care Card
- Payment for forms
- Eye glasses if worn

These forms must be submitted within 45 days of receiving it. Our office will be able to fax the form for you once completed to the Superintendent Office in Victoria.
