

Travel Clinic

Travel assessments are recommended for travelers to most destinations outside North America and Europe. If you are unsure in this regard, visit cdc.gov and find their travel health section which is an excellent resource for travelers. During this consult the doctor will:

- Review your health history, previous vaccination history, and travel itinerary
- Write your prescriptions
- Give health advice
- You may be required to go for labs to check immunization status
- Discuss the recommended/required vaccines

Travelers should come in at least 4-6 weeks prior to travel. Travel consults are not covered by MSP; there is a fee of \$40.00 per person which includes the consult and first injection. Keep in mind your physician will write your prescription and if you come back on the same day your injection is paid for. All subsequent injections have a fee of \$15.00. Some reduction in the fees may be made for families coming in together at the consult.

Our office does not keep travel injections in stock; we do have a pharmacy adjacent to our office that stocks common vaccines such as Twinrix (Hepatitis A & B), Havrix (Hepatitis A), Typhoid and Dukoral. Check with your insurance provider to see if travel vaccines are covered under your plan.

Please bring the following to your visit:

• Records of prior vaccinations both travel and regular (childhood) vaccinations, if available.
